GUIDELINES FOR ARTICLES TO APPEAR IN THE FOURTH ISSUE OF THE ENGINEERS JOURNAL 2018

"The Engineer" is a Journal of the Engineers Registration Board (ERB) and is published annually. Articles published in "The Engineer" Journal are of engineering nature and associated services. The ERB encourages articles from all Engineering Disciplines (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, etc.). The First Issue 001 was published in September 2015 and unveiled during the Engineering Forum of September 2015. The Second Issue 002 was similarly published in 2016 as part of the activities of the Engineers Forum. The Third Issue 003 was similarly published in 2017 as part of the activities of the Engineers Forum. The Fourth Issue is under preparation, and will also be unveiled at the Engineering Forum slated for 25th-26thOctober 2018.

Guidelines for the Engineers Journal 2018

- 1. Submitted Articles should not exceed a maximum of 1500 words;
- 2. Articles can be sourced from engineering projects being undertaken at the author's place of work / organization Case Studies;
- 3. Articles can be from completed or on-going Research at Universities, Companies, and other Research Institutions;
- 4. Articles in the form of Technical Notes summarizing content of Engineering Reports submitted for purposes of registration with the ERB are also acceptable;
- 5. Articles shall be original work of the author(s) with clear acknowledgement of work from other sources. The Harvard style of referencing shall be used.
- 6. The Authors must submit passport photos (high resolution in jpg format) and a brief biography of 100-200 words.
- 7. All submissions should be in the English Language, prepared using Microsoft Word Application Version 2010 or earlier, and in Times New Roman Font Size 12 with single line spacing. The Margins should be 2.54 cm all-round.
