



ENGINEERS REGISTRATION BOARD (ERB) CALL FOR TRAINING OF ELECTRICAL ENGINEERS IN EGYPT

The ERB recently signed an MoU with the Egyptian Syndicate of Engineers (ESE) for mutual cooperation in the engineering discipline including training. In this vein therefore the ESE and ERB have arranged for a four weeks training in Cairo during the **Period 11th February – 11th March 2019** for 20 (twenty) electrical engineers.

The course outline is: Conceptual electric design, Load estimate (preliminary single line diagram), Bulk equipment (Transformers, generators, UPS), Medium and low voltage switch gears, lighting design, Small power, MEP coordination, Cables and busbar, Power network calculations and panel schedules, power quality, Earthing and Green Energy (Solar, smart panel, KNX system).

Qualifications: Applicant must be a Ugandan, graduate electrical engineer from a recognised university in the field of construction with electric power background. He /She should also indicate the date of birth, Education background, employment status and attach copy of national ID.

Sponsorship: ERB in conjunction with ESE will meet the cost of Tuition, accommodation, meals and internal transport within Egypt. The applicant will meet the cost of return air ticket, Visa, out of pocket expenses, medical insurance where necessary and any other expense that may arise not covered under ERB and ESE arrangement.
