GUIDELINES TO APPLICANTS FOR REGISTRATION WITH THE ENGINEERS REGISTRATION BOARD (ERB)

1.0 Who should apply for Temporary Registration?

The provision for Temporary Registration is for a person who is not ordinarily resident in Uganda but intends to be in Uganda in the capacity of a professionally qualified engineer only for the express purpose of carrying out specific work or works for which he/she has been engaged.

2.0 Who Qualifies for Temporary Registration

A person applying for temporary registration is required to demonstrate that he is, or immediately prior to entering Uganda was, in practice as engineer in such a capacity as to satisfy the Board of his fitness to serve the public as a professionally qualified engineer.

3.0 Obligation to Register

It is an obligation under the law for any professional engineer coming to work in Uganda to register within four months of his arrival. It is also obligatory for any firm or organization, private or public, which recruits such a professional in Uganda to ensure that such engineer registers within the stipulated time period.

4.0 Period covered by Temporary Registration

The Board registers an applicant for temporary registration for a period of one year or for the duration of any specific work or works of engagement. In case of the latter, registration ceases on termination of the work or works.

5.0 Scope of Registration

A person under temporary registration is treated as a registered engineer under the law only in relation to the period of registration and to such works in question; but in relation to other matters shall be treated as not so registered.

The scope of temporary registration is therefore specific to the subject of registration.

6.0 How to apply

The procedure of application is as follows;

- Obtain and fill form ERA 2
- Attach an up to date career report
- Attach copies of certificates
- Attach recommendation letter from employer and Ugandan employment agency (client) confirming the project you are currently or have worked on.
- Attach proof of registration with an engineering body in your home country

Return to the Registrar, Engineers Registration Board. P.O. Box 29267, Kampala.

The applicant will be informed of the outcome of the application within a period of 14 days including the fees to be paid, where applicable.

The Board may require an applicant to appear before it for the purposes of considering his/her application and shall require every applicant to produce documentary evidence of his/her work or employment immediately prior to his/her entering Uganda.

The application will be processed to completion within a period of 30 days from submission.
